AN ACT RELATIVE TO NATIONAL GUARD BONUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 16 of Chapter 130 of the Acts of 2005 is hereby  
2 amended by striking out in the first sentence the words “or Opera-  
3 tion Noble Eagle” and inserting in place the following:—

4 Operation Noble Eagle, Massachusetts national guard members  
5 activated under Title 32 for more than 30 consecutive days in sup-  
6 port of contingency emergency operations related to Operation  
7 Noble Eagle, or Massachusetts national guard members activated  
8 for state active duty for more than 30 consecutive days in support  
9 of contingency emergency operations related to Operation Noble  
10 Eagle.
