AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN PAYMENT BY THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the
2 Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement Board shall pay to Thomas P.
3 Johnson all interest accrued on the sum of \$38,000 which sum was
4 paid to him on December 31, 2002 as reimbursement for sixteen
5 years of back payments which were unlawfully withheld from his
6 retirement allowance. Said interest shall be calculated for the period
7 commencing on March 31, 1986 through and including December
8 31, 2002 at a rate of interest as set forth in Section 6(I) of Chapter
9 231 of the General Laws.
