AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VOTING PRACTICES OF THE FRANKLIN REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (w) of Section 567 of Chapter 151 of the acts of 1996,
2 as amended by Section 124 of Chapter 204 of the acts of 1996 and
3 Section 4 of Chapter 344 of the acts of 1998, is hereby further
4 amended by striking out the 9th sentence and inserting in place
5 thereof the following sentence:—

6 The nomination papers of candidates for any generally elected
7 positions created by said charter proposal to be filled at a state elec-
8 tion shall be signed by 150 voters.
