Lt. Governor Karyn Polito's Schedule for Thursday, June 1, 2017

BOSTON – Tomorrow, Lt. Governor Karyn Polito will participate in the Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting of the new headquarters of Cold Chain Technologies (CCT) in Franklin. CCT, a provider of temperature-controlled packaging solutions for the life sciences, is also commemorating its 50th anniversary.

After that, she will join Attleboro Mayor Kevin Dumas and local legislators on a tour of Thomas Willet Elementary School, followed by an announcement of Digital Partnership Capital Grants that will help develop technology infrastructure and strengthen digital learning at 40 schools across the Commonwealth. The visit is part of the Baker-Polito Administration's ongoing series of education events to highlight initiatives, programs and funding opportunities from early education to college level, all aimed at providing a quality and affordable education for every student in the Commonwealth.

Later, the Lt. Governor will participate in the ribbon-cutting for the T Wharf reconstruction project in Plymouth's Harbor. Plymouth received a \$2 million MassWorks award during the 2015 competitive grant round to support the construction of the new T Wharf. She will then attend the ceremonial groundbreaking for North Plymouth's Revitalization by celebrating the start of construction for the Loring Boulevard, funded with a \$2 million MassWorks grant.
