That, since their former Report on this subject, they have ascertained that Elisha Mack, one of the ten persons named as having the highest number of votes in the District of Essex, died between the second Monday of November last, and the first Wednesday of January current; and the Committee further report, for the information of the Senate, that Dan. Weed, Jr., has the highest number of votes for Senator after the ten persons mentioned in their former Report; he having twenty-six hundred and eighty-one votes. They submit the former Report, without further modifications.
