AN ACT

To repeal "An Act to establish a Police Court in the Town of Taunton."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The one hundred and twenty-seventh
2 chapter of the acts of the year one thousand eight
3 hundred and forty-nine, entitled "An Act to estab-
4 lish a police court in the town of Taunton," is hereby
5 repealed: *provided, however*, that the justice of said
6 court may finish the proceedings in any case now
7 pending in said court.
