### AN ACT

In addition to "An Act to regulate the use of Railroads."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The compensation of commissioners who  
2 may hereafter be appointed in accordance with the  
3 provisions of the one hundred and ninety-first chapter  
4 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and forty-  
5 five, and the two hundred and ninety-first chapter of  
6 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven,  
7 shall be paid by the respective corporations in such  
8 proportions as said commissioners shall determine.

1    SECT. 2. The fourth section of the one hundred  
2 and ninety-first chapter of the acts of the year  
3 eighteen hundred and forty-five, is hereby repealed.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after  
2 its passage.
