### R E S O L V E

In aid of the erection of a Fence around Fort Washington.

*Resolved*, That the sum of two thousand dollars be, and the same is, hereby appropriated for the erection of an iron fence around Fort Washington, in the city of Cambridge: *provided*, the city of Cambridge shall appropriate a sum sufficient to complete said fence, at a cost of not less than four thousand dollars, the whole to be expended under the direction of the adjutant-general, in connection with a committee of the city council of the city of Cambridge, and the governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant therefor accordingly.
