IN SENATE, February 14, 1860.

The Committee on Education, to whom was committed the Order of January 25, 1860, in regard to the appropriations from the income of the School Fund, report the accompanying Resolutions.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty.

R E S O L V E S

In aid of the Westfield and Salem Normal Schools, and for other purposes.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand and five hundred dollars be allowed and paid, to enable the Board of Education to enlarge the State Normal School building at Westfield, so that it shall be sufficient for the accommodation of one hundred and twenty pupils.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be allowed and paid to enable the Board of Education to furnish the State Normal School building at Salem, with new furnaces, to cement the cellar, to paint the rooms, and to provide for the library.

Resolved, That the secretary of the Board of Education be authorized to prepare and publish a hand-book, for the use of the committees and teachers, based upon the General Statutes, concerning public instruction.
