AN ACT

Ratifying the Election of Town Officers, in the Town of
Harwich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The election of town officers in the town
2 of Harwich, made at the annual town meeting on
3 the sixth day of February, in the year one thousand
4 eight hundred and sixty, so far as the same may be
5 illegal, for the reason that the check list was not used
6 in the election of said officers, is hereby ratified and
7 confirmed; and the same shall be taken and deemed
8 good and valid in law, to all intents and purposes
9 whatsoever.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
