AN ACT

For the Return of Officers' Fees for Service of Warrants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 All warrants issued under the provisions of the
2 seventy-fifth chapter of the General Statutes of this
3 Commonwealth, may be returned to the clerks of the
4 superior court, and all fees thereon shall be allowed
5 in the same manner that costs are now allowed in
6 criminal proceedings.
