AN ACT

In addition to an Act to Define the Costs of Criminal Prosecutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. All fees for services in criminal cases,
2 rendered or performed by any constable, city marshal,
3 or other officer, who receives a salary for his official
4 services from a city or town, shall be allowed and
5 taxed as in behalf of other officers; but all said fees
6 shall be paid to the city or town from which such
7 officer receives his salary.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
