Resolved, That the secretary of State be and he is hereby authorized to cause to be collected and repaired the instruments used in the survey of the State, and to deposit the same in his office, and that a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to be expended by the secretary of State for the purpose herein before mentioned.
