AN ACT

Concerning the appointment of Inspectors of the Hospital
at Rainsford Island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The term of the inspectors of the hospital at
2 Rainsford Island, now in office, shall terminate at
3 the expiration of three years from the date of their
4 appointment respectively; and the governor, with the
5 advice and consent of the council, shall appoint a
6 board of three inspectors of said hospital residing in
7 the immediate vicinity thereof, and one member at
8 least of said board shall be appointed annually.
