In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT

To incorporate the North Adams Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. E. R. Tinker, H. L. Dawes, John B.
2 Tyler, their associates and successors, are hereby
3 made a corporation by the name of the North Adams
4 Gas Light Company, in Adams, for the purpose of
5 manufacturing and selling gas, in the town of Adams,
6 with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all
7 the duties, restrictions and liabilities, set forth in the
8 sixtieth and sixty-eighth chapters of the General
9 Statutes.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation may, for the purpose
2 aforesaid, hold real estate not exceeding in value

3 twenty thousand dollars, and the whole capital stock
4 shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 3. Said corporation, with the consent of the
2 selectmen of the town of Adams, shall have the
3 power and authority to dig up and open the ground
4 in any part of the streets, lanes and highways in said
5 town for the purpose of sinking and repairing such
6 pipes and conductors as may be necessary for the pur-
7 pose aforesaid; and the said corporation, after opening
8 the grounds in such streets, lanes or highways, shall
9 be held to put the same again in repair under the
10 penalty of being prosecuted for a nuisance: *provided*,
11 that the selectmen of said town may regulate, restrict
12 and control all acts and doings of such corporation
13 which may in any manner affect the health, safety,
14 convenience or property of the inhabitants of said
15 town.
