R E S O L V E

To cancel expenses incurred on the Buildings of the Massachusetts School for Idiotic and Feeble-Minded Youth.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the treasurer of the School for Idiotic and Feeble-Minded Youth, the sum of three thousand dollars, to be applied on the debt already incurred for building purposes under the direction of the trustees.
