AN ACT

Concerning the Stoneham Branch Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Stoneham Branch Railroad Compa-
2 ny, incorporated under the two hundred and sixty-
3 eighth chapter of the laws of the year eighteen hun-
4 dred and fifty-nine, are hereby allowed to construct
5 their railroad across highways and town ways at such
6 grade and in such manner as the county commission-
7 ers may specify and direct.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
