AN ACT

To amend "An Act to incorporate the Fall River and Warren Railroad Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The time limited in the fifth section of the act
2 approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and
3 fifty-seven, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Fall
4 River and Warren Railroad Company," within which
5 the location of said railroad should be filed, is hereby
6 further extended to the first day of July, eighteen
7 hundred and sixty-two, and the time in said section
8 limited within which said road should be constructed
9 and completed with at least one track, is hereby
10 extended to the first day of July, in the year eighteen
11 hundred and sixty-four.
