### AN ACT

To provide for Additional Pay to our Militia in the Service of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1.   The governor shall offer and pay to every  
2 private and non-commissioned officer of the Massa-  
3 chusetts militia, who has been, since the first day of  
4 April in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four,  
5 mustered into the service of the United States, or  
6 who shall be hereafter mustered into said service, as a  
7 part of the Massachusetts militia, the sum of twenty  
8 dollars monthly, so long as he shall remain in said  
9 service; and this shall be in full discharge of all  
10 claim upon the Commonwealth for pay, bounty and  
11 state aid.

1   SECT. 2. The payment provided for in the first  
2 section of this act shall be made in manner and form  
3 as prescribed for payment in chapter two hundred and  
4 fifty-four of the laws of the year eighteen hundred  
5 and sixty-three, and the provisions of said chapter  
6 relating to the manner of payment are hereby made  
7 applicable to the same.

1   SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
