AN ACT

To establish the Boundary Line between the Towns of
Rochester and Wareham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—*

1 SECT. 1. The governor is hereby authorized, by
2 and with the advice of the council, to appoint three
3 commissioners, whose duty it shall be, after having
4 duly notified the clerks of the towns of Rochester
5 and Wareham, to investigate all matters in dispute
6 relative to the boundary lines between the towns of
7 Rochester and Wareham, where said towns join, and
8 establish and define by proper monuments, said
9 boundary lines between the said towns.

1 SECT. 2. The commission hereby established shall
2 have full power to examine the premises, and send

3 for persons and papers, and shall submit a report of
4 their doings to the next legislature.

1 SECT. 3. The expenses of said commission shall
2 be borne equally by the towns of Rochester and
3 Wareham.

1 SECT. 4. The act of the year one thousand eight
2 hundred and sixty-four, to define the line between
3 the towns of Rochester and Wareham, is hereby
4 repealed.
