AN ACT

Relating to the Salaries of the Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 From and after the first day of April, in the year
2 one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, the chief
3 justice of the supreme judicial court shall receive an
4 annual salary of five thousand five hundred dollars,
5 and each of the other justices of said court shall
6 receive an annual salary of five thousand dollars,
7 from the treasury of the Commonwealth.
