AN ACT

Concerning the Springfield and Longmeadow Railroad
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. Section two, chapter two hundred and
2 thirty-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
3 and forty-nine, incorporating the Springfield and
4 Longmeadow Railroad Company, revived and ex-
5 tended by chapter eighty-one of the acts of the year
6 eighteen hundred and sixty-four, is hereby amended
7 so far as to permit the location and construction of
8 said railroad upon a route terminating at the south
9 line of the state, either in the town of Longmeadow
10 or Wilbraham.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation may have a capital stock
2 not less than one hundred and fifty thousand dollars,
3 and not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars, in
4 shares of one hundred dollars each.
