AN ACT

To extend the Time for Constructing the Melrose and South Reading Horse Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 Sect. 1. The time allowed for the construction of
- 2 the Melrose and South Reading Horse Railroad is
- 3 hereby extended to the first day of April, in the year
- 4 eighteen hundred and sixty-seven.
