AN ACT

In relation to the payment of Bounties to Persons Enlisting in the Naval Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The governor is hereby authorized to pay
2 to any person enlisting in the naval service for a term
3 which secures the Commonwealth more than a single
4 credit upon its quota, a bounty for all such credit
5 above a single credit, at the rate of one hundred dol-
6 lars for a single credit: *provided however*, that all the
7 provisions and restrictions of sections three and four
8 of chapter two hundred and eleven of the acts of the
9 year eighteen hundred and sixty-four shall be appli-
10 cable to this bounty: and, *provided further*, that the
11 governor, with the consent of the council, may

12 suspend by proclamation the operation of this act
13 whenever he shall deem it expedient.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.

It is evident by inspection the operation of this set
is superior to that of the ordinary.
