Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Mr. JACKMAN, of Newburyport, moves to further amend the second section of the Bill for the sale of intoxicating liquors, by striking out, in the fifth line of said section, the words, "as the public convenience may require," and inserting in place thereof the following words:—

1 Not less than one person in each town, and two
2 in each city, if that number should apply to be
