AN ACT

To exempt from Attachment the Earnings of the Wife
and Minor Children of a Debtor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. No person shall be adjudged a trustee
2 by reason of any money or credits in his hands, due
3 for the wages of the personal labor or services of the
4 wife or minor children of the defendant in trustee
5 process.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
