### AN ACT

Authorizing the building of a side-track to connect with  
the Hanover Branch Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. George Curtis, of Hanover, is hereby  
2 authorized to construct and maintain a side-track or  
3 tracks, to connect his iron works in said town of  
4 Hanover with the Hanover Branch Railroad, subject  
5 to the provisions of all laws which now are or may  
6 hereafter be in force relating to railroads crossing  
7 highways.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
