AN ACT

Authorizing the Temporary Home for the Destitute to hold additional real and personal estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. The Temporary Home for the Destitute
2 is hereby authorized to hold real and personal prop-
3 erty to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand
4 dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
