AN ACT

To authorize the Vermont and Massachusetts Railroad Company to take land in Fitchburg for Depot and other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Vermont and Massachusetts Rail-
2 road Company are hereby authorized and permitted to
3 purchase, or otherwise take, so much land between
4 Laurel and South Streets in the town of Fitchburg,
5 including a small parcel adjoining the land of said com-
6 pany on the easterly side of South Street, including in
7 all not over one acre, for depot, station or track pur-
8 poses, and to construct additional tracks thereon, cross-
9 ing said Laurel and South Streets at the grade thereof.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation shall, in relation to
2 such land, be entitled to all the rights and privileges,

3 and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and restric-
4 tions set forth in the general laws relating to such
5 corporations.

1 SECT. 3. All persons who shall sustain any dam-
2 age in their property by the taking of such land
3 shall have all the rights and remedies given by the
4 general laws.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from its
2 passage.
