The Committee on Harbors, to whom was referred the petition of Charles J. Nye and others, of Falmouth, for leave to extend their wharf, report the accompanying Bill.

AN ACT

To authorize Charles J. Nye and others to extend their Wharf in Falmouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. License is hereby given to Charles J.
2 Nye, James Witherell, Alvin Nye, F. G. Nye,
3 Thomas G. Nye and Peter E. Childs and others,
4 owners of a wharf situated at Rocky Point Landing
5 in the town of Falmouth, built under authority of
6 the one hundred and second chapter of the acts of
7 the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, to extend
8 said wharf fifty feet into tide-water: *provided*, that
9 all things done under this act shall be subject to the
10 determination and approval of the harbor commis-
11 sioners, as provided in the fourth section of chapter
12 one hundred and forty-nine of the acts of the year

13 eighteen hundred and sixty-six; and *provided*, that
14 this license shall in no wise impair the legal rights of
15 any person; and *provided, further*, that this license
16 may be revoked at any time, and shall expire at the
17 end of five years after its taking effect, except so far
18 as valuable structures may have been actually and in
19 good faith built under the same.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
