AN ACT

In addition to an Act for Supplying the Town of Pittsfield with Pure Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The town of Pittsfield is hereby author-
2 ized to issue from time to time notes, scrip or certifi-
3 cates of debt, to be denominated on the face thereof
4 “Pittsfield Water Scrip,” to an amount not exceeding
5 fifty thousand dollars, in addition to the amount now
6 authorized by the fourth section of chapter two hun-
7 dred and ten of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
8 and fifty-two, and by chapter two hundred and one of
9 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six,
10 in the same manner, upon the same terms and con-
11 ditions, and for the same purposes as stated in said
12 acts.

1 SECT. 2. The town of Pittsfield is hereby fully
2 authorized to assess and collect upon the polls and
3 estates, real and personal, in the Pittsfield fire dis-
4 trict, all taxes necessary to pay the principal and
5 interest of the scrip that shall be issued under the
6 provisions of the preceding section.

1 SECT. 3. There shall be a legal meeting of the
2 voters of said fire district called within one year after
3 the passage of this act, for the purpose of having the
4 said voters give in their written votes on the question
5 whether they will accept this act ; and if two-thirds
6 of said votes shall be in the affirmative, then the
7 selectmen of the town of Pittsfield shall warn a meet-
8 ing of the voters of said town within three months
9 after, for the purpose of having said voters give in
10 their written votes upon the question whether they
11 will accept the same ; and if two-thirds of said votes
12 given upon the question aforesaid be in the affirma-
13 tive, then this act shall be binding ; otherwise, null
14 and void.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
