### AN ACT

In relation to the Granite Railway Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—*

1    SECT. 1. The Granite Railway Company is hereby  
2 authorized to carry on the business of quarrying and  
3 cutting stone, and for that purpose may hold real and  
4 personal estate not exceeding, together with all real  
5 and personal estate now held by them, the sum of  
6 two hundred and fifty thousand dollars ; and all acts  
7 done by said company in purchasing real estate for  
8 that purpose, and in carrying on said business, are  
9 hereby confirmed.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
