AN ACT

To change the Name of the Proprietors of the Odd Fellows' Hall in the City of Boston, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. The proprietors of the Odd Fellows'
2 Hall in the city of Boston, shall hereafter be called
3 and known as the Odd Fellows' Hall Association.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to
2 maintain a building in said Boston for the purposes
3 of an Odd Fellows' Hall, and any other lawful pur-
4 pose.

1 SECT. 3. The organization of said corporation,
2 and all acts done in pursuance of its charter are
3 hereby confirmed.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
