AN ACT

To revive the Charter of the Taunton Street Railway
Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. Chapter eighteen of the acts of the year
2 eighteen hundred and seventy is hereby revived and
3 continued in force, and the time for organizing the
4 corporation authorized thereby, and the acceptance of
5 said act by the city council of Taunton, and the
6 location, construction and operation of the street rail-
7 way therein authorized, is hereby extended one year.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
