AN ACT

To incorporate the Brookline Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Edward Atkinson, John C. Abbott,
2 Moses Williams, Jr., their associates and successors,
3 are hereby made a corporation by the name of the
4 Brookline Savings Bank, to be located in the town of
5 Brookline; with all the powers and privileges, and
6 subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions
7 set forth in all general laws which now are or may
8 hereafter be in force in this Commonwealth relating
9 to institutions for savings.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
