AN ACT

To regulate the use of Wenham Lake for Bathing purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. Whoever shall bathe in Wenham lake
2 within five hundred yards of the mouth of the con-
3 duit pipe, of the Salem water works, in North Bev-
4 erly, shall for every such offence be punished by a
5 fine not exceeding ten dollars.

1 SECT. 2. All prosecutions under the preceding
2 section, shall be instituted within thirty days from the
3 time of committing the offence.
