### AN ACT

To incorporate the Winchester Savings Bank in Winchester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—*

1    SECT. 1. John T. Manny, A. K. P. Joy, Henry  
2 B. Metcalf, Daniel N. Skillings, J. F. Dwinell and  
3 Stephen Cutter, their associates and successors, are  
4 hereby made a corporation by the name of the Win-  
5 chester Savings Bank, to be located in town of Win-  
6 chester; with all the powers and privileges, and sub-  
7 ject to the duties and liabilities set forth in the fifty-  
8 seventh chapter of the General Statutes, and such  
9 other laws of this Commonwealth as relate to insti-  
10 tutions for savings.

1    SECT. 2. The said corporation is hereby author-  
2 ized to purchase and hold real estate in Winchester  
3 for their own use, not exceeding twenty thousand  
4 dollars in value.
