## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy  
One.

### AN ACT

To incorporate the Orange Savings Bank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. Edward Barton, Rodney Hunt, Davis  
2    Goddard, N. L. Johnson, their associates and suc-  
3    cessors, are hereby made a corporation by the name of  
4    the Orange Savings Bank, to be located in the town of  
5    Orange; with all the powers and privileges, and sub-  
6    ject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions, set  
7    forth in all general laws, which now are or may here-  
8    after be in force in this Commonwealth relating to  
9    institutions for savings.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2    sage.
