One.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Young Woman's Apprentice Associa-
tion.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. Jennie Collins, Mary French, E. M.
2 Cutting, and their associates and successors, are here-
3 by made a corporation by the name of the Young
4 Woman's Apprentice Association, to be established in
5 a suitable locality, for the purpose of enabling young

6 women to become skilled in the various branches of
7 industry, so essential to the welfare of the community;
8 with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all
9 the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all
10 general laws which now are or may hereafter be in
11 force relating to such corporations.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation may hold real and per-
2 sonal estate not exceeding ten thousand dollars in
3 value, for the aforesaid purposes.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
