AN ACT

To authorize the appointment of a Clerk of the District Court of Southern Berkshire.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. There shall be appointed and commis-
2 sioned by the governor a clerk of the district court of
3 southern Berkshire, who shall perform all the services
4 required by law of the clerks of like courts in this
5 Commonwealth; and said clerk shall receive an an-
6 nual salary of three hundred dollars, to be paid from
7 the treasury of the Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect so far as the
2 appointing, commissioning and qualifying the clerk
3 of said court is concerned upon its passage, and it
4 shall take full effect on the first day of July next.
