## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-One.

### AN ACT

Concerning State Aid.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-two of  
2 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six,  
3 and the acts in addition thereto, shall be construed to  
4 grant allowances of aid to or on account of a child of  
5 a soldier born subsequently to his death; and all pay-  
6 ments of aid by any city or town to or on account of  
7 such child shall be reimbursed to such city or town  
8 by the state.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
