AN ACT

To amend the Acts incorporating the Massachusetts
Agricultural College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. Chapter two hundred and twenty of the
2 acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, entitled an
3 act to incorporate the trustees of the Massachusetts
4 Agricultural College, is hereby amended as follows,
5 to wit:

6 Strike from the first section thereof the words,
7 “ whenever vacancies shall occur in the board of trus-
8 tees, the legislature shall fill the same,” and substi-
9 tute therefor the words, “ also from time to time to
10 elect new members.”

11 Strike the last sentence from the fifth section and
12 substitute therefor the following: “ the college shall
13 furnish to the governor and council a copy of the
14 annual report of its operations.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
