AN ACT

To amend Section seventeen of Chapter one hundred and forty-five of the General Statutes, concerning informations in the nature of *quo warranto*.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Section seventeen of chapter one hun-
2 dred and forty-five of the General Statutes, is hereby
3 amended by adding thereto the words, “or before any
4 justice of the court in vacation.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
