AN ACT

Making appropriations for the Maintenance of the Government for the present year.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are ap-
2 propriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purposes specified, to meet expenses for the year
5 ending on the thirty-first day of December, in the
6 year eighteen hundred and seventy-two, to wit:—
