AN ACT

To continue in force an Act to incorporate the Hingham
and Cohasset Mutual Fishing Insurance Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. The act of the year one thousand eight
2 hundred and fifty-two, chapter thirteen, entitled “An
3 Act to incorporate the Hingham and Cohasset
4 Mutual Fishing Insurance Company” shall be con-
5 tinued and remain in force from and after the twelfth
6 day of February, in the the year one thousand eight
7 hundred and seventy-two, and said company shall
8 continue to have and enjoy all the powers and privi-
9 leges, and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and
10 restrictions set forth in the general laws which are

11 or may be in force relating to such corporations, in
12 like manner and to the same effect as if said act in-
13 corporating said company had contained no limita-
14 tion of time.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
