AN ACT

Relating to the appointment and to fix the salaries of the Officers in attendance upon the Civil sessions of the Superior Court of the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 SECT. 1. The officers in attendance upon the
- 2 civil sessions of the superior court of the county of
- 3 Suffolk, shall hereafter be appointed by the court,
- 4 and shall receive an annual salary of one thousand
- 5 dollars each, payable monthly from the county trea-
- 6 sury.
- 1 Sect. 2. This act shall take effect from the first
- 2 day of April, eighteen hundred and seventy-two.
