### AN ACT

To limit the Term of Service of Jurors in Suffolk County  
and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. Hereafter, no person shall be compelled  
2 to serve as a traverse juror in any of the courts of  
3 Suffolk County more than thirty days at any term of  
4 court, except to finish a case commenced within that  
5 time.

1    SECT. 2. Section second of chapter one hundred  
2 and thirty-two of the General Statutes is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the words, "members of the  
4 ancient and honorable artillery company."

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
