N ACT

To incorporate the Standish Monument Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. George Bradford, Thomas Chandler,
2 Charles H. Chandler, their associates and successors,
3 are hereby made a corporation by the name of the
4 Standish Monument Association, for the purpose of
5 erecting and maintaining in the town of Duxbury a
6 monument to the memory of Miles Standish; and for
7 this purpose shall have all the powers, and be subject
8 to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities set forth
9 in all general laws which now are or hereafter may
10 be applicable to such corporations.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation shall have authority to
2 take and hold such land on Captain's Hill, in said

3 town of Duxbury as shall be necessary or convenient
4 for the purposes aforesaid: *provided*, that the land as
5 taken shall not exceed three acres in area, and that
6 such taking shall be in accordance with the laws for
7 the taking of lands in the location and construction
8 of highways; and *provided, also*, that such land shall
9 not be taken until at least five thousand dollars of the
10 capital stock of said corporation shall have been sub-
11 scribed and paid.

1 SECT. 3. If at the expiration of five years from
2 the passage of this act the contemplated monument,
3 built of stone or other permanent material, shall not
4 be erected and completed, the title to all land taken
5 under [and by virtue of this act, shall revert to its
6 former owner, his heirs or assignees, upon the repay-
7 ment by him or them of the sum received as compen-
8 sation or damages for such taking.

1 SECT. 4. The capital stock of said corporation
2 shall be fifty thousand dollars and be divided into
3 shares of one hundred dollars each.
