AN ACT

To amend Chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the
General Statutes, in relation to Forcible Entry and
Detainer.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. All actions and proceedings hereafter
2 commenced before a district court, under and by virtue
3 of chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the Gen-
4 eral Statutes, or any act or acts in amendment thereto,
5 shall be heard and determined by one of the justices
6 of said court, subject to the right of appeal to the
7 superior court, as provided in said chapter.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
