EXTRA REPAIRS, &C., 1872.

- Painting the outside of the State House.
- Painting and whitening Governor's Room and Council Chamber, and repairing plastering in same.
- Painting and whitening Green Room.
- Repairing slate, copper and tin roofs, gutters and conductors.
- Repairing sidewalk in front of State House.
- New floor, &c., in adjutant-general's fire-proof.
- Making cases for auditor and agent board state charities.
- Repairing deck of colonnade.
- Resetting flag-stones and steps in front of State House.
- Repairing tiling in Doric Hall and entries.
- Shelving room off Senate for documents.
- Painting, whitening and oil-cloth, watchmen's room.
- Ventilators for tax-commissioner's office.
- Repairing plastering in governor's private entry and washroom.
- Plumbing and repairs on wash-bowls and water-closets.
- Sewers and gutters inside lower gate, front.

Estimated cost of above, \$11,000.
